Companies consider this when hiring, selecting scholarship recipients, and even determining whether to accept you into their program!

Username & Passwords

Save your login and

passwords! I can't stress this enough! It's very frustrating when you get ready to start working but have to spend 10 minutes resetting your password because you didn't save it somewhere secure!

Memorize Important Numbers

Number. This is a number you will
have to use over and over again.
It should be kept in a very safe,
private place where others don't
have access to it. You also need
to memorize your address (both
mailing and physical if different)
and your parent's full names.

Financial Aid Graduation Requirement

You MUST do one of the three things:

- 1. Complete & submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- 2. Complete & submit a Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA)
- 3. Submit a signed opt-out form
